

Labor Category Descriptions and Qualifications – Minimum Qualifications Experience Equivalency

Experience: Refers to the minimum years required in engineering and/or related technical and managerial fields. Specialized experience refers to the minimum number of years required related to the particular appropriate skills for a labor category.

Substitution of Education for Experience: A bachelor's degree may be substituted for two years of experience for those labor categories requiring a high school diploma. A master's degree may be substituted for four years of experience for those labor categories requiring a high school diploma. A master's degree may be substituted for two years of experience for those labor categories requiring a bachelor's degree.

Substitution of Experience for Education: Two years of experience for each year of education may be substituted for the next degree. However, no experience substitution is allowed for a high school diploma. The allowable substitutions are as follows:

- High school diploma plus additional 8 years = bachelor's degree;
- High school diploma plus additional 12 years = master's degree; and
- Bachelor's degree plus 4 additional years = master's degree.
